(d) Salinity of the interstitial water

No interstitial water could be obtained from the sand at station 1. The salinity of the water from the surface 2.5cm of sand at station 2 was $23.4^{\circ}/_{00}$, and at station 3, $31.11^{\circ}/_{00}$, both low. Salinities higher than that of local sea-water $(35.3^{\circ}/_{00})$ were recorded at stations 4, 5 and 6, and at the remaining stations they ranged closely around $35.3^{\circ}/_{00}$ (see Appendix I).




Fig. 8.—Surface sand data.




Fig. 9.—Sub-surface sand data.
