share in this training scheme and when the expansion is completed at the end of this year, the annual out- put will be 900 pilots fully trained, 500 pilots partially trained, and 1500 ob- server and air gunners partially train- ed, all of whom will complete their training in Canada," said Mr. Jones. "It may not be generally appreciated that a large staff of ground personnel is required to man the various schools necessary to carry out our training commitments. All these men are per- forming an essential service and are contributing most effectively to the successful prosecution of the war. Without their whole-hearted and effec- tive co-operation it would be abso- lutely impossible for New Zealand to provide her quota under the Empire air-training scheme. It must be ob- vious to everyone that unless adequate reinforcements are provided for the Royal Air Force that service cannot keep up the high pressure against the Germans which they are doing at the present time."
