### MYSTIC MUTATION CHANGING CARDS.

A FINE DRAWING-ROOM FEAT.  
EASILY PERFORMED YET VERY SURPRISING.



This very clever illusion can be performed with either one or two cards. The most effective way is to exhibit a card in each hand, say the King of Diamonds and the Queen of Spades. While closely watched and at the full arms' length apart, the cards suddenly change, the King and the Queen reverse positions. With one card the transformation can be done by merely passing the hand over the King and it becomes the Queen, then, in full view of the audience, and held by the tips of the fingers of one hand, the Queen of Spades, after being breathed upon, visibly changes back to the King of Diamonds.
