
units. Dets. will keep records of instructors available in all subjects for which there is any demand.

- (c) Discussion Groups, to discuss matters of general interest. ERS will distribute on request authoritative data in a form suitable for discussion purposes.
- (d) Lectures, Brains Trusts, Quiz Sessions. ERS will supply material, and where required, notes on their conduct. Dets. may be able to arrange for exchange of Brains Trusters.
- (e) Musical and Art Appreciation. Most of the material for these classes is held by Div. Det. which will make it available to Div. Units on request.
- (f) Film Service. In co-ordination with and under the control of the existing Y.M.C.A. service, a mobile film service operating from Formation HQ will show documentary and educational films round units.
- (g) Hobby Huts. Units will need to furnish instructors in woodwork, metalwork, perspex work and general arts and crafts when establishing these. If instructors prove in short supply a loan of instructors from other units for short periods for training purposes will be arranged.



- (h) Elementary courses in Home Gardening and in the petrol engine for the owner-driver. Units should have no difficulty in finding instructors. ERS will supply text-books where necessary.
- (i) Information and Reading Rooms. These will be provided on a Unit scale.

ERS will supply material for stocking them, together with suggestions for maintaining interest in them, e.g., by wall-newspapers and information displays.

## At Formation Level

- (a) Classes in subjects for which there is insufficient demand to make them practicable at unit level, or where the instructors or facilities are too few to be made available to units.
- (b) Library Service. Formation libraries have been provided and are in operation. Where necessary units will be served by mobile libraries, but whenever possible Formation Libraries will be concentrated. This gives the individual a better choice of books, and saves labour.
- At 2 NZEF Level, HQ ERS will provide the following services, additional to those provided by Detachments:—
- (a) Information Service to answer questions of a general nature for those who have no access to a reference library or where detachment reference libraries cannot give an answer. No questions of a military nature will be answered.
- (b) Overseas scholarships and bursaries are arranged by a committee of 2 NZEF. Applications for these must be submitted to ADERS by 30th September, 1945.
- (c) Publications. CUE, published twice monthly, will contain regular information regarding the scheme, and will continue, as in the past, to provide general historical and informational material. CABs and Koreros will be distributed through Dets.
- 2 NZEF SCHOOL OF EDUCATION, attached to HQ ERS, includes the Correspondence School and also acts as agent for the University of New Zealand and for various other examining bodies.
